# Get Ready! 16th House Project To Begin This Spring



**O**nce again spring is right around the corner! As the snow melts and the ground thaws we look forward to the groundbreaking of another Habitat for Humanity home. This home, located on the 1300 block of Grand Avenue in Sheboygan, is the 16th home built in Sheboygan County by Habitat for Humanity Lakeside since its inception in 1993.

The groundbreaking for this home is scheduled for April 30th at 2 p.m. This is the busiest time of the year for our building and volunteer committees. Committee members are working to finalize the details of the building plans, secure contractors, and most importantly to schedule volunteers to help us with the build.

We are looking for people who have knowledge of home construction and the ability to teach others to serve as crew leaders. Crew leaders are an important part of the building process as they are the ones who teach inexperienced volunteers how to do things. We also need inexperienced volunteers who are willing work on the home. Building a home takes roughly three months, so every person's time and talents are needed.

Donated resources such as lumber, shingles, siding, windows, doors, carpet and cabinets are always a big help in offsetting the costs of building a Habitat home. Monetary donations are always accepted and go a long way to help defray costs.

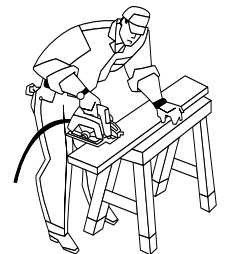
